## Vertebrate Species Management Program (VSMP) formerly the Wild Dog Program

The VSMP has been formed to more accurately reflect the broader scope of the program which will include the management of a greater range of vertebrate species impacting agricultural production and environmental values. Dingo management to support producers experiencing livestock losses will still be a key function of our staff.

Initially the VSMP will utilise events such as our annual Vertebrate Species Management Zone workshops, formerly Wild Dog Management workshops, to gain local knowledge on the range of vertebrate species impacting both public and private land, and as with dingo management areas will be prioritised for management activities based on level of impact and resourcing. Where opportunities arise for collaboration coordinated management strategies and training will also be considered.

The VSMP will:

- Work with land managers and community to protect livestock and livestock production from the impacts of predation
- Deliver coordinated management actions on a range of vertebrate species that will provide enhanced outcomes for biodiversity and landowners
- Build awareness and understanding with stakeholders, agency partners, landholders and community of the program rebrand and broadened focus of control programs to include other vertebrate species
- Continue to raise awareness and recognition of the valued relationships that the Vertebrate Species Management Program team (previously known as the Wild Dog Program) hold with key stakeholders
- Build a partnership approach with Traditional Owners to build healthy Country on a self-determined basis.

### Face-to-face community meetings

The face-to-face community drop-ins are an opportunity for you to discuss predation management with your local Vertebrate Species Management Officer and provide input on the Vertebrate Species Management Program's proposed predation control occurring from 1 July 2025 to 30 June 2026. The drop-ins will aid in the development of community approaches for predation control in each of the fifteen Management Zones.
