



Swifts Creek Hall Committee

On the 23/3/1938 a public meeting was held to discuss the means of erecting a new Mechanics' Hall. From the meeting a building committee was formed from members of the Hall Committee and representatives of the Cricket Club, Golf Club, Bible Club and Mothers' Club.

It is interesting to note at the time there was much opposition to the large size of the proposed building.

The Hall was finally built and opened with a ball on the 31s March 1939, admission being 10/6 double and 7/6 a single gent, and 4/- for a lady. Mr F. Sutton was M.C.

The builder was Mr. H.Mordant whose tender was £1,383-15-0.

The building was declared open by the Hon. Albert Lind, who was the Member for Gippsland. (PAGE 39)
